

Work Carried Out by Third-Party Companies for Jungfraubahnen

Scope / Purpose

This policy applies to all types of repair and maintenance work carried out by third-party companies on behalf of Jungfraubahnen on its premises or sites, unless otherwise agreed. The following provisions serve to ensure personal safety and to prevent accidents, damage and operational disruptions. All applicable legal requirements as well as Jungfraubahnen's guidelines and safety regulations must be observed. For work within the track area, Annex RTE 20100 applies. Depending on the nature of the assignment, additional safety instructions will be provided before work commences at the respective workplace.

Safety Instructions

Employees of third-party companies must report daily to the responsible contact person at Jungfraubahnen (or their deputy) at the place where the work is being carried out, both on arrival and departure.

1. Employees of third-party companies may only remain in the agreed locations (storage areas, workplaces, etc.). The designated route to the workplace must be used; shortcuts across railway tracks, etc., are strictly prohibited. Unless otherwise agreed, tools and equipment must be provided and maintained by the third-party company. Personal protective equipment (PPE) must be worn in the areas defined by Jungfraubahnen.
2. The third-party company is responsible for informing itself about potential hazards related to the assignment, instructing its employees accordingly and taking appropriate precautions. The responsible contact person will inform the third-party employee on site about any specific conditions requiring special attention (e.g. unmarked escape routes). Employees of third-party companies must comply at all times with safety-related instructions issued by Jungfraubahnen staff.
3. The third-party company is responsible for ensuring that all required safety measures are communicated to and implemented by its employees.
4. Smoking is strictly prohibited in all Jungfraubahnen buildings and in outdoor guest areas.
5. The third-party company is responsible for maintaining order, cleaning and the environmentally responsible disposal of materials. Careful use of resources (water, electricity, etc.) is expected by Jungfraubahnen.
6. For work generating heat, smoke, dust, etc., the responsible contact person must be informed before work begins. If a fire detector, sprinkler system or other safety device is damaged, or if an alarm is triggered, this must be reported immediately. The contact person must also be informed without delay once the work has been completed.
7. In the event of malfunctions, fire, accidents or other safety-related incidents, the responsible contact person must be notified immediately.
8. In the event of non-compliance with this policy or with instructions issued by Jungfraubahnen employees, any resulting damage may be charged to the third-party company. In the case of fire alarms resulting in the deployment of the fire brigade, the applicable fire brigade tariff will be charged.

By accepting the assignment, the third-party company acknowledges Jungfraubahnen's safety instructions and is responsible for ensuring that its deployed employees are informed of these regulations.
